Dear Prayer Partner,

Winter is upon our brothers in Chile. Last week a rainfall of 63 millimeters (that's 2.5 inches!) doused the city of Santiago in just 2 days. And now the building is leaking because it does not have a roof.

That's why we are writing you today: to ask that you help us put the roof on the New Life Baptist Church. While the Church is functioning in their new building, rain leakage is beginning to cause deterioration of the new installations.

The reason why this needs to be done can be seen readily in the lives being touched through the counseling and the college ministries. While both ministries are underway, not having a room to meet in limits the outreach and impact of them.

Dealing with the leakage takes valuable time away from meeting with and counseling young adults. However, one of the girls reached through the counseling ministry is a young woman named Susan (not her real name). Her drug abuse and family tensions created deep hurt and struggles in her life. With her relationship with her parents at a low, she heard about the counseling ministry of New Life and decided to give it a try. Soon into the counsel-

ing it became apparent that there were deep issues of rebellion against God, which she was directing toward her family. Once she confessed that need, she found acceptance and hope in Christ to rebuild her life. She is now active in the college group (see photos on back).

In order that our outreach to college students and others can continue, we invite you to prayerfully consider a gift of \$100 to \$500 that will enable us to get the roof on the Church. Of course the amount is up to you, and all gifts will be cheerfully received, just as they are cheerfully given! The Lord chooses to entrust resources to each of us. Then he directs us to opportunities to invest them in something that will touch lives. Here is an way you can touch handicapped children, college students and families for eternity in Santiago.

This is the ideal time to invest in the lives of the hundreds who will be touched by New Life Baptist Church and Ministry Center. With newly adjusted figures in hand, the updated cost of the third floor will be \$220,000. That includes the roof, trusses and columns, the external block wall, all the flooring, ceiling

and partitions, as well as the windows, doors, electrical and plumbing.

The exciting fact is, we have \$20,000 in hand, and there is a promise for \$30,000 later this year! That leaves a need of \$170,000 to get the third floor up. This is our prayer request now.

*A generous gift of \$275 from every church and individual on our mailing list would enable the entire need to be met! Please consider helping New Life Baptist Church have their roof and third floor walls **complete this year.***

Once the third floor is built, then more work teams can be scheduled to come and assist in finishing the classrooms. These rooms are **CRITICAL** in our ministry to children with learning disabilities, to college youth needing a solid foundation for life, as well as the counseling ministry, the music academy and the deaf outreach. All this depends on completing the third floor!
